

COMPLETED CONTRACT

Site and Location: Civic Offices and Library for Carlow County Council.



Carlow County Council required a signature building in Tullow to relocate their local offices. This prestigious 2,100m² building provides one centralised stop within Tullow for the County Council Offices, Library and a Local Information Technology access hub.

The building was constructed using composite concrete and steel frame solutions of distinctive geometric profile with decorative masonry in-fill, clad with specialist reinforced glass, granite panels and coloured render. Initial site enabling works of soil stabilisation and piling was also undertaken. We also completed all ancillary site structures, drainage, roadworks, paving, and underground services. An element of protective heritage works was also undertaken.

The building was constructed in line with sustainable building techniques further securing a LAMA award.
