As part of the overall refurbishment to the National Library of Ireland, a protected structure, CLG's remit included the complete upgrading of the offices, circulation areas, public arenas and storage facilities and the total reinstatement of all Mechanical & Electrical and Data Infrastructure.

The project involved the alteration of all amenities in Microfilm Storage. Demolitions, alterations, upgrading of partitions, ceilings, doors, skirtings and the internal finishes were also carried out in various administration, circulation and public areas of the library.
