

COMPLETED CONTRACT

Site and Location: Irish Rail Period Contract.



Irish Rail employed CLG as part of its period contract upgrade plan for its countrywide network infrastructure works, to upgrade, refurbish and build 46 railway stations and refurbish 16 of its bridges.

The scope of the works varied from station to station. These included demolition works, earthworks, excavations, anti contamination works, construction of under track crossings, services ducts, drainage and new track slabs. Many of the works were also carried out along canals and involved working over and under water.

Temporary works were carried out to maintain full use of the stations by the public and IE staff, calling upon diligent Health & Safety, Traffic Management and Liaison practices from CLG Management.
