

COMPLETED CONTRACT

Site and Location: Royal Kilmainham Hospital East Gate Alterations, Dublin 8.



The OPW selected CLG to carry out alterations to the existing gated entrance and the re-alignment of the entrance and approach avenue to the East Entrance to the Irish Museum of Modern Art at the Royal Hospital Kilmainham.

The works carried out under the contract consisted of the demolition of the existing retaining wall and taking up existing stone kerbs for re-use. The locating and diverting of all services in the area. The construction of a new avenue approach to revised levels which was finished with a coloured tarmacadam. New reinforced concrete retaining walls were constructed. The restoration of existing retaining walls through the stripping of lime plaster and re-plastering of new and existing walls with traditional lime plaster. The existing pathways were demolished and new wider pathways were built on both sides of the avenue.
