Site and Location: South Tipperary County Council, Countrywide Water Conservation.



Since 2006, 300 leaks were detected by South Tipperary County Council with a further 1,200 detected in the following two years. The leak shown above was found in Killenaule, and its repair saved 140,000 litres per day.

In order to upgrade and improve its water infrastructure network system S.T.C.C. employed CLG Developments Ltd to undertake major remediation works to pipelines, valves, chambers and water metering units.

The main activities associated with this project were as follows; the installation of meters, valves, pressure control devices with data collection capabilities, leak detection and repairs. In certain areas where the condition of the pipes were deemed unsuitable for repair new pipes and apparatus were installed.

This project delivered on our commitment to sustainability and care of the environment.
